Planning is key

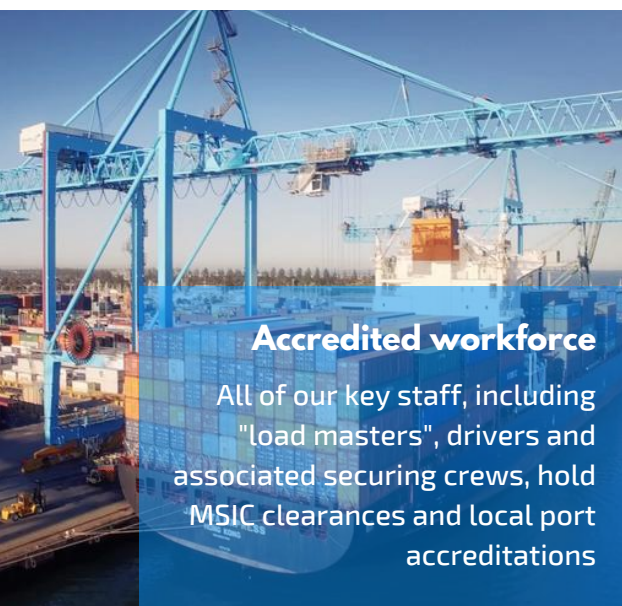
- We create custom-made project plans in close cooperation with our customers, project managers, Health and Safety Department and field supervisors
